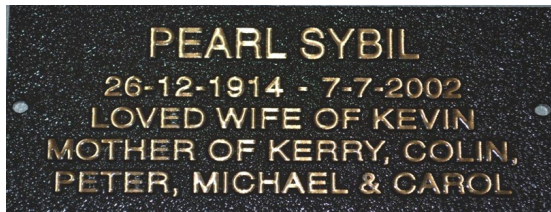

Remembrance Plaques

Standard Remembrance Plaques with standard wording can be purchased for placement on the memorial wall, in memory of those whose remains are interred elsewhere. For example if you have a loved one buried in a cemetery, in Bunbury, anywhere in Australia or overseas, you may wish to have them remembered on the Cathedral Memorial Wall. 6 Memorial Wall plaques will be allocated to one brick on the wall. The size of the plaque is 135mm x 65mm



Many hours of research has gone into the size, inscription, and protective coating of the plaques. The plaques are included in the fee. The parish, together with the design company has prepared a template and standard formatting of the font and size for plaques.

FAQ's

Who maintains the Memorial Wall ?

The Parish Columbarium Committee will be the administrator for the Memorial Wall supported by the Bishop, the Parish Council and the Parish Finance Committee.

Eligibility for a Plaque on the Memorial Wall ?

Having a plaque placed in their memory on the Memorial Wall is available to Parishioners (current or past), their spouse, children, parents or siblings, Parishioners from the Diocese of Bunbury or their relatives. Other requests will be considered by the Parish Columbarium Committee.

Who orders the plaques ?

The Parish will automatically order the approved standard template for the place or memorial wall. The Family will be responsible for carefully checking accurate spelling, of the name and date on the plaque of their loved one.

Visiting Hours ?

The Columbarium and Memorial Wall will be open every day of the week for families to visit, pray, and remember at any time. The Cathedral Precinct gates will be locked as per usual at night.

How can I find out more about the Memorial Wall ?

The Parish will run regular information evenings to explain the specifics of the Cathedral Columbarium. Dates will be advertised in the bulletin and you are welcome to purchase places at these sessions.

Will there be Masses to pray for the souls of those remembered on the Wall of Remembrance ?

There will be an annual Mass and rosary to remember and pray for the repose of the souls of those interred in the columbarium or who are remembered on the Wall of Remembrance. All the deceased members of the parish and their families and loved ones are also remembered at all Masses celebrated at the Cathedral.

Payment ?

Full payment is required at the time of purchasing the plaque. Pre Payments are also available to reserve a place (or block of places for a family) in the stage that is open at the time.

Fees

A standard plaque with inscription \$440.00 (Inc GST). A Family Block with a 20% discount on the total price is applicable where 4 or more places are reserved.
